Consent Form for Participation in a Research Study

Study Title: Evaluation of the Building our New Dads (BOND) Program

Introduction

You are invited to participate in a research study to evaluate the Building of New Dads (BOND) pilot program for soon-to-be fathers.

This consent form will give you the information you will need to understand why this study is being done and why you are being invited to participate. It will also describe what you need to do to participate and any known risks, inconveniences or discomforts that you may have while participating. We encourage you to take some time to think this over and to ask questions now and at any time. If you decide to participate, you will be asked to sign this form and it will be a record of your agreement to participate. You will be given a copy of this form, too.

Why is this study being done?

We are doing this study to see how useful the BOND program is for soon-to-be fathers. We will look at questions answered before and after taking the program to see if it is helpful to fathers.

What are the study procedures? What will I be asked to do?

Part of the eligibility requirements for this study are that you be at least 18 years of age; therefore, if you are filling out this form in person, you will be asked to show ID that can verify your age. If you are returning this form via mail, please bring ID with you to the first program session to verify your age. If you do not have a driver's license or other ID or documentation that can verify your age (i.e., that shows your birthdate), please let the researcher know, and the researcher will have to make a personal determination as to whether s/he feels confident that you are at least 18 years of age and thus eligible to participate in the study.

If you agree to be a part of this study, you will be asked to fill out a total of four surveys. An initial survey will ask you questions about the health of the baby and mother, how much you know about your growing baby, and how you feel about becoming a father. The purpose of this survey is to get to know you and your family before entering the next phase of the study. This survey will be completed at the beginning of the first BOND program session.

Next, you will take part in the BOND program and will attend a total of four 1 ½ hour group sessions. These sessions will occur every other week for 8 weeks at [location] and the program should be finished before your baby is born. The program will be held either in the evening or on the weekend depending on when you and other fathers are available. Each group will include 6-8 soon-to-be fathers. Food will be provided at each session that is appropriate to the timing of the session (e.g., lunch, snack, or dinner). Each session will cover a different subject, such as how your baby is growing during the pregnancy, parenting tips, and what to do and expect as a father
